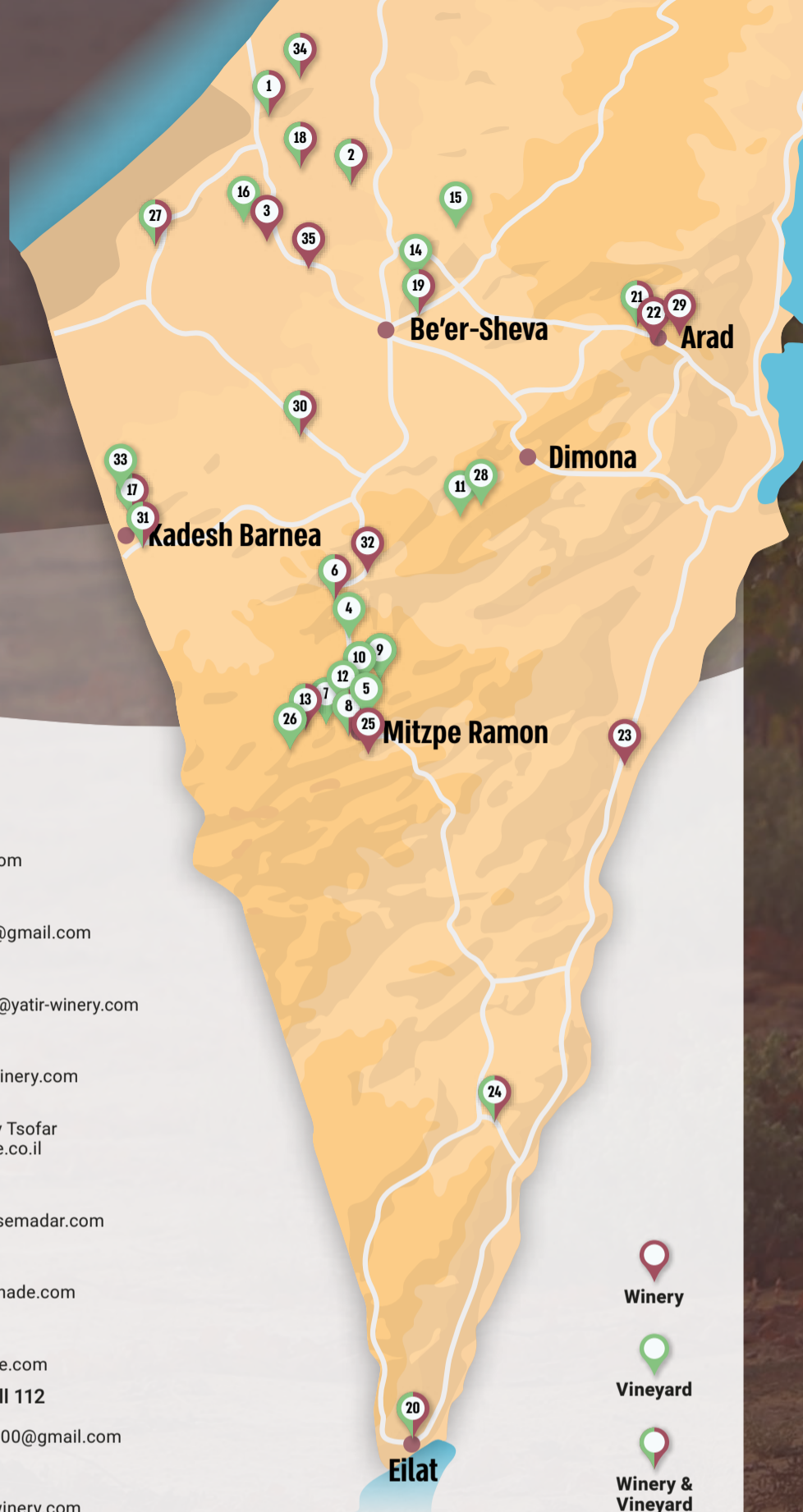


















NEGEV DESERT TERROIR

The hardships of the Negev desert carry veiled virtue. Seemingly hostile conditions emerge as favorable. The heat of the day, loess soil - rich in salt yet otherwise deficient, and sun's reflection from the beaming ground—all pose enduring challenges to Negev vintners. It is the dry air, sharp temperature drops, and cold winters that nurture the region's wine grapes. The distinctive conditions cultivate the unique terroir of the Wine of the Desert - are beginning to be recognized by international oenophiles.

Vineyards grew in the Negev during the biblical period as early as 3,000 years ago, as well as during Roman and Byzantine rule. In recent decades the dormant vines of ancient roots are revived with a new wave of planting. White grapes harvested before the acid in them falls,

leave white Negev wines crisp and minerally, with echos of stone fruit. Red grapes from the region often have thin and unripe skin, yielding a light and cheerful wine to drink.

Negev vineyards and wineries exhibit that when ancient traditions and pioneering agricultural innovations are aptly coupled, fine wine can be produced even under the harshest desert conditions. The burgeoning wineries emerging within the majestic desert landscapes position the Negev as an alluring global tourism destination offering a new regional engine for growth.
